### **CALL TO ORDER**

The KRADD Regional Transportation and Safety Planning Committee meeting was called to order at 10:05 AM by Secretary Mayor Charles Dixon. He welcomed those in attendance.

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Roger Friley made the motion to approve the Minutes from the August 19<sup>th</sup> meeting. The motion was seconded by Judge Cale Turner. Motion carried. The Minutes are on file in the KRADD office.

### **GUEST SPEAKER**

Charlie Spalding with the KYTC Division of Planning Central Office discussed the FY 2011 Prioritization Process and Guidelines. A brief explanation of the Unscheduled Project List (UPL) and Prioritization was given to new members. Below are a few highlights from his presentation:

- Focus and build upon 2009 UPL Prioritization Results
- Reduced listing – “Double High” (ranked high by the region and district)
- Projects for I-66 and the Appalachian Development Highway System (ADHS) will not be considered.
- Highway District Planners and ADD Transportation Planners will reevaluate each project and determine if there is a defensible need.
- HDO and Regional Rankings will be obtained by cost tier.
- An overall top 10 will be submitted by the HDO and ADD.
- Timeline: February 28, 2011: review and add projects; March 31, 2011: HDO Prioritization and Ranking; July 29, 2011: ADD Prioritization and Ranking.

### **BUSINESS**

- Eunice discussed the Draft FY 2011 Prioritization Plan distributed to those present. The Committee will be reviewing projects to be prioritized and approving new projects at the February 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Projects will then be prioritized by cost tier on May 11<sup>th</sup>. An Overall Top 10 listing will also be developed. Priorities and rankings are to be submitted by the ADD to the KYTC by July 29, 2011.
- Mrs. Holland presented the Big Sandy Regional Driving Experience Facility (BSRDE) Concept Plan. Jamie Pinson, Big Sandy ADD Transportation Planner developed the plan. The plan insists of seeking funding for a closed-course driver training facility. The facility will teach drivers of any age safe driving practices. The Regional Committee was presented with a resolution to approve and support the concept of a regional driver training facility, and to further approve and support additional investigation into the feasibility of establishing such a facility in eastern Kentucky. Jim McDannel made the motion to pass the resolution. Mayor Scott Cornett seconded the motion. Motion carried.
