Based on the information submitted, it does not appear that a permit would be required for the above referenced project as no discharge of fill or dredged material is proposed within aquatic resources as long as any proposed stream crossings would be conducted via directional boring. Directional boring/drilling is not a regulated activity. 












BREATHITT COUNTY WATERLINE EXTENSIONS PHASE 2 JOE WARD FRK RD FLOODPLAIN MAP
