TRANSPORTATION PLANNING 2021 PRIORITIZATION

The KYTC developed a more data-driven, objective and collaborative approach to determine the state's transportation funding priorities. Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) is a prioritization model that will bring balance and dependability to Kentucky's over programmed highway plan.

SHIFT uses quantitative data such as crashes, fatalities, traffic volumes, delays, employment to assess the benefits of planned projects and compare them to each other. The program also includes collaboration with local leaders throughout the process to help shape regional funding priorities. Through this collaboration, projects were selected for prioritization by being sponsored at the regional or Area Development District (ADD) level, Highway District Office (HDO) level and Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) level. KRADD held local meetings, virtually and in-person, to determine projects to sponsor.





The projects selected for regional sponsorship were submitted to the KYTC Central Office Planning and loaded into the SHIFT formula. Regional lists were provided, not selected through the statewide process. The projects were scored in the SHIFT regional model, which used weighted values for data available: safety, asset management, congestion, freight, benefit/cost ratio, District and Local (ADD/MPO) priorities.

Ten (10) of the projects on the regional lists were then selected by the Regional Transportation Committee (RTC) to receive 15 priority points. Projects identified to receive priority points met the selection criteria identified by the prioritization plans developed by each District and ADD. The Highway District Office (HDO) also selected projects to receive 15 priority points. Double-Boost projects that are selected by both the KRADD RTC and HDO will have 30 points added to their score. The Boost and Double-Boost projects are highlighted on the following pages.

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Aging Services Participant Directed Services Program

Participant Directed Services (PDS) is a Medicaid Waiver program available for those participants who want to self-direct their in-home services. With this program, participants can choose who will provide their needed services; as well as, how and when the service will be provided. Services approved through PDS may include personal care, home-making, and respite. In order to hire their own employee, clients must have Medicaid and be approved for a service budget.

KRADD’s role in the program is to provide case management and financial services. Our case managers work with the client to help them get Waiver services approved, design a plan of care, hire employees, and monitor the client’s services on a monthly basis. Our financial management team processes payroll for the clients’ employees and ensures all taxes are reported on the clients’ behalf. During the pandemic, this program saw a major increase in the number of new clients our agency is serving. During FY 21, our agency served 364 PDS clients and 408 individuals were employed to provide services to those clients.

Title III Nutrition Program

The Nutrition Program in the Kentucky River Region is provided in Letcher, Leslie, Knott, Perry, Lee, Owsley, Breathitt and Wolfe counties. The goal is to reduce hunger and isolation among our 60-plus population. The program provides senior citizens 60 years and older access to nutrition services (both Congregate and Home Delivered) in each of the KRADD area's eight counties.

During the pandemic, the request for Home Delivered meals in our region increased 65% and Congregate meal demand increased 81%. With the addition of CARES and ARPA funds, we were able to remove all clients from our waiting list and serve many more seniors with their immediate needs. Without additional funds being budgeted, 439 seniors in our District will lose meals and be put back on a waiting list when the ARPA & CARES funds are spent.
